### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. Shri Digamber Jain Higher Secondary School is a premier educational institution run by Shri Digambar Jain Samaj, a minority community with special privileges of Dimapur Town. The course of instruction comprises of all branches of education as prescribed by the Government of Nagaland & Nagaland Board of School Education. Besides, greater emphasis is given to moral instructions. The classes are run from Pre-Primary to Higher Secondary Level. Higher Secondary (Science & Commerce Streams) classes are run only for Girls.
- 2. The aim of the Institution is to impart quality education by cultivating habits of piety, hard work, discipline, love for the century old traditions, culture and values of life to the children. Hence particular attention is given to discipline and character formation by means of religious and moral instructions.

### **ADMISSION**

- 3. New Admission is given only to Nursery. Other admissions, if any, will depend on the availability of seats and merit of the student.
- 4. Admission to Nursery
  - (i) A child who have completed 3½ years or above by January can be admitted to class Nursery.
     Duly filled in Application Form should be submitted in the office with the following documents.
    - (a) 2 copies of recently taken passport size photo.
    - (b) 2 attested photo copies of the date of birth certificate issued by the competent authority.

- 5. Admission to Other classes (LKG to Class 8)
  - (a) Duly filled in Application Form
  - (b) Two copies of recently taken Pass Port Photo.
  - (c) Transfer Certificate and Pupil Cumulative Record (PCR) from the institution previously studied.
  - (d) 2 attested photo copies of the Date of Birth Certificate issued by the competent authority.
  - (e) Progress Report of the Last Examination Appeared.
- 6. Students coming from outside the state of Nagaland should submit the Original Mark Sheet and Transfer Certificate counter signed by the DEO of the area.
- 7. New pupils must be introduced by the parents/guardian, who will be responsible for their regularity, conduct and payment of school fees.

### **FEES PAYMENT**

- 8. Fees will be received only during office hours and shall be paid on or before 10th of every month. After 10th of every month, a late fine of Rs. 10/- will be imposed.
- 9. Pupils failing to pay fees for three consecutive months shall have their names struck off from the roll. They may, however, be re-admitted on clearing all arrears and fines.
- 10. No School leaving certificate will be issued to students unless all the dues are paid in full.
- 11. Pupils failing to clear all dues will be debarred from sitting for examinations. Absence from examinations does not mean exemption from paying examination fees.
- 12. Parent or Guardian must pay the fees only to the Accountant or the person entrusted by the principal. No fees should be paid to the class teachers or any other staff of the school.

- 13. The school will not be responsible for loss of money by the student which is brought to the school for payment of fees.
- 14. A receipt should be obtained from the Accountant for the fees paid before leaving the counter. The fee receipt should be kept in safe custody for future references.
- 15. The Fee Card must be produced at the time of payment of fees.
- 16. In case of cancellation of Admission by the parent, no reimbursement of fees is allowed.

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

- 16. It is compulsory for the students to come to the school in Uniform as specified below:
- 17. The School Uniform (for class 1 to 10):
  - i) White Shirt (Boys & Girls)
  - ii) Grey Pants (Boys)Grey Pleated Skirt knee length (Girls)
  - iii) School Tie
  - iv) School Belt
  - v) White School Socks
  - vi) a. White Canvas Shoe (Nursery to Class VII) b. Black Rexene Shoe (Class - VIII to XII)
  - vii) a. Maroon Sweater with School Logo (Nursery to Class X)
    - b. Maroon Blazer with School Logo (Class XI-XII)
  - vi) On Wednesdays and Saturdays students should wear the group colour T Shirt and White shoe.
  - vii) Maroon Tie and Belt are compulsory for both Boys and Girls. These articles are supplied from the school on payment.

- 18. The uniform should be stitched as per the specification and requirement of the school uniform rules. Fashionable, tight fitting (Shirt & Long Pant) and short skirt are not allowed.
- 19. Students coming to school with wrong uniform will be sent back.

**Note:** There is a separate uniform for Higher Secondary Classes. For details refer to the prospectus.

### TIFFIN/LUNCH

20. The school has started canteen services from this academic session, however it is not compulsory for the students to use the canteen services. Students are advised to bring tiffin of home made vegetarian food. All kinds of packet foods, junk foods and other forms of eatables like dry noodles, chewing gum, chips etc. are not allowed in the school.

### NON VEGETARIAN FOOD IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE SCHOOL.

### **EXAMINATIONS**

- 21. Pre-Primary to Class 7 evaluations are done under CCE as per the SCERT Nagaland Guidelines. And for Class 8 12 Examinations and CCE is done under Nagaland Board of School Education. There will be Board Examination under Nagaland Board of School Education at the end of the course for these classes.
- 22. Progress report will be sent to the parents after completion of Quarterly Evaluation/Unit Tests and Terminal Examinations. It should be signed by the parent and should be returned to the class teacher on the next day.
- 23. It is compulsory that one of the parents should report in the school to sign in the progress report after the quarterly/ terminal examinations.

- 24. Students academic and non academic performance will be assessed throughout the year. Minimum 80% attendance is required to sit for the Terminal Examination.
- 25. Decision with regard to Examination result and promotion to the next higher class taken by the school authority would be final. There will be no re-consideration of result.

STUDENTS WITH LESS THAN 80% ATTENDANCE ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO SIT IN THE FINAL EXAMINATION/BOARD EXAMINATION

### **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 26. Special attention is given to ensure a high standard of morality and discipline among the students by enforcing regular attendance and punctuality. Periodical reports will keep parents informed of the progress of their children.
- 27. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, insubordination to teachers, any kind of cheating or serious misconduct, even outside the school premises, or any habit or behaviour injurious to the moral tone of the school will lead to the rustication of the student from the School at any time of the year.
- 28. No child suffering from contagious or infectious disease shall be permitted to attend the school.
- 29. Any communication (request or complaint) made by parents should be addressed to the Principal and not to the Class Teacher. Letters written in English or Hindi only will be accepted.
- 30. Parents and guardians are not allowed to see their children or interview teachers during class hours.
- 31. All pupils must speak only in English in the class/school premises otherwise a fine of Rs.50 will be imposed per occurrence.

- 32. The name of the pupil who absents himself/herself for more than 30 days without leave application will be struck off from the attendance register.
- 33. Any damage done to the school property in the Class or School premises must be made good by the pupil. Besides Rs.5000 must be paid as penalty.
- 34. Ornaments excluding chain, tops and rings are not allowed in school. To prevent loss of articles like umbrellas, rain coats, Tiffin carriers etc. the articles should be marked with name of the child. Students with tattoo marks will not be allowed to continue in the school.
- 35. The school cannot be held responsible for accidents, small or serious to pupils during school hours due to the negligence or restlessness of the child.
- 36. The school Diary/Almanac is a record concerning the student. Therefore, every student should take special care of this record and bring it to the class every day. In case of lose of diary, the student should obtain a written authorisation from the principal to buy a new diary.
- 37. Anyone using unfair means in examination will be debarred from further examinations. He will be declared to have failed and may even be expelled from the school.
- 38. Students failing in the same class for two consecutive years may be asked to leave the school or may be expelled.
- 39. No magazines, papers, or books other than school text books, may be brought to the school without the permission of the Principal. Parcels and letters are subject to inspection.
- 40. Mobile Phone, I Pad, Tablet computers, I Pod, Cameras etc are strictly prohibited in the school. These gadgets will not be returned. For a second time offence, the student will be expelled from the school.
- 41. It is compulsory that student should be in full uniform when ever they come to the school for any purpose.

### **LEAVE OF ABSENCE**

- 42. No pupil should absent himself/herself without obtaining leave previously.
- 43. Pupils must return after long vacations on the appointed day. In case of sickness an application with medical certificate from a registered doctor must be produced at the time pupil recovers and attends the school.
- 44. Leave application from the students should be supported by the signature of the parent/guardian concerned.
- 45. Leave of absence should be duly recorded in the column provided in the calendar and signed by the parents.
  - USE OF NON VEGETARIAN FOOD, TOBACCO PRODUCTS, GUTKAS, ALCOHOL OR ANY OTHER BANNED SUBSTANCES IN THE SCHOOL PREMISES AND ALSO OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL IN UNIFORM WILL LEAD TO THE IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF THE DEFAULTER FROM THE SCHOOL.
  - A STUDENT WHO INVOLVES IN HOOLIGANISM, GANG-FIGHT, PHYSICAL ASSAULT, SEXUAL HARASSMENT, RAGGING, INTIMIDATION, INVOLVEMENT IN STEALING, BURGLARY OR ANY OTHER OFFENCE THAT BREAK THE LAW OF THE COUNTRY INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL WILL LEAD TO THE IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF THE DEFAULTER STUDENT.

### **REQUEST TO PARENTS**

46. a) Parents or guardians on their part will study and understand the School rules and regulations carefully and observe them faithfully.

- b) Parents are earnestly requested to enforce regularity and discipline at home and see that their children prepare their lessons and do the assigned homework/ assignments/project works regularly.
- c) Criticism of teachers in the presence of the pupils must be avoided because it causes the student to lose his/her respect for his/her teacher and ultimately affect the moral tone of the institution. Hence parents are requested to meet the principal for any clarification.
- d) Due to any reason, if a parent is called to office of the principal for the welfare of their child, they should meet the principal in time without hasitation.
- e) All the parents are requested to come and join the parent-teachers meet with your valid suggestion without fail for the welfare of your children and betterment of the institution.
- f) We encourage you to have cashless transaction.

#### TO BE SIGNED BY THE PARENTS

I hereby acknowledge that I have gone through the rules and regulations of the school given above and do hereby undertake that I shall have no objection whenever the school takes up appropriate actions against my ward/wards in case he or she violates the above provisions or fails to observe discipline.
