II. Elective (2 subjects) : Biology, Mathematics, Informatics Practices

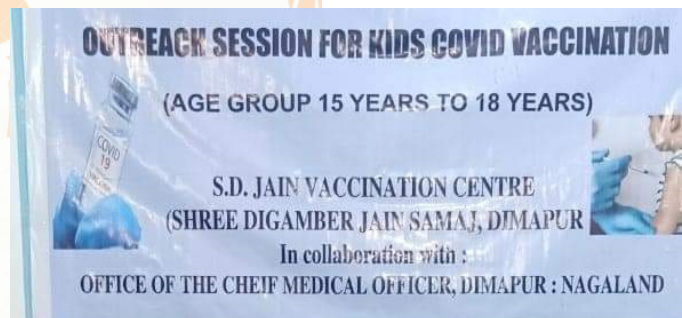

2. Must have secured minimum qualifying Grade 'C2' in Mathematics.
* The school authority reserve the right to fix a higher grade for admission in case there are excess number of applicants.
3. Admission for Boys is limited to boys who passed out class 10 from within school.
4. Admission will be granted on first come first serve basis.

Subjects of studies

I. Compulsory : English, Economics, Accountancy, Business Studies

II. Elective : Entrepreneurship

III. Additional Subjects (Any One) : Alternative English, Hindi, FBM, Informatics Practices

IV. Internally Assessed Subjects : Environmental Education, Work & Art Education, Physical & Health Education

In addition to the normal course of study under the subjects chosen by the student, he/she is required to give extra time to complete assignments, project works and activities under work education, physical and health education subjects which are internally assessed. Failure to comply with this, the student will not be allowed to appear the Board Examination. ■



Documents need to be submitted at the time of submission of the application form.

- ✓ Attested Photo copies (2 nos each) of the HSLC Examination Mark Sheet-cum-Pass Certificate and Admit Card.
- ✓ Photo copy of pass certificate.
- ✓ Photo copy of the character certificate issued from the institution last attended. (For the students coming from other boards.)
- ✓ 2 (two) copies of recently taken passport photo
- ✓ Migration Certificate must be submitted those students seeking admission from other Board.

Documents Required for Admission

- ✓ Original Marksheet, Original Admit Card with two attested copies of each.
- ✓ CRSH Book for the students of NBSE, Kohima
At the time of interview/counselling one of the parents of the candidate must be present

System of Examination:

- ✓ Regular and Periodic Class Tests..
 - ✓ Unit tests after every one and half months.
 - ✓ Mid Term and Selection Test.
1. Test Marks will be informed to the parents by sending the answer books and progress report for signature.
 2. Students who are irregular will not be allowed to sit for the Selection Test.
 3. It is mandatory that the students should have 80% of attendance to be eligible for the Board Examination.
 4. Students who have opted for subjects involving practical shall not be allowed to take the practical examinations in case the candidate does not fulfill the attendance requirement.
 5. A student can be detained from appearing Board Examination on account of any of the following reasons
 - a) If there is no sign of academic improvement or if the student has deteriorating performance in the weekly/unit tests and terminal examinations.
 - b) Gross misconduct and insubordination to the school authority
 - c) Failure to attend the coaching classes.
 - d) Non-payment of fees (School Fees, Examination Fees, etc.)
 - e) Failure to abide by the rules of the school.
 - f) Or any other reason which the head of the institution necessitates to take an action.





Pass Criteria and classification of successful candidates of class XI

- i) 33 Marks in each subject not involving practical/assignment.
- ii) 21 marks in theory and 12 marks in practical separately for those subjects involving practical.
- iii) 30 marks in theory and 3 marks for assignment/project for all other subjects.
- iv) D grade or above for internally assessed subjects.
- v) 165 marks in the aggregate out of 500 marks.
